During our last Reading Club we read a book called “White Fang”. It was written by Jack London.



My Favourite Book


My favourite book is “The Hobbit” by J. R. R. Tolkien.


My favourite Animal English Bulldogs


Racoons

My Pet Rutka

I own a Djungarian hamster, also known as the Siberian hamster or Siberian dwarf hamster. Its name is Rutka.

Hamsters are rodents that are kept as house pets. In the wild, hamsters remain underground during the day to avoid being caught by predators. They feed primarily on seeds, fruits, and vegetation, and will occasionally eat burrowing insects. They have quite big cheek pouches in which they carry food back to their burrows. When full, the cheeks can make their heads double, or even triple in size(!).

The Djungarian hamster is ball-shaped, and is one of the smallest hamsters species, therefore is called a dwarf hamster. You can recognise the Djungarian hamster by a thick, dark grey stripe on its back. They originally come from Dzungaria, the wheat fields of Kazakhstan, the meadows of Mongolia and from Siberia. The Djungarian hamster is not an aggressive

species. It is sociable and feels well surrounded by people.

My hamster, Rutka, is very sweet, doesn't bite at all, loves burrowing herself, and gnawing at things, even her cage. Rutka is small and runs really fast. She is very cute because of her large cheek pouches and tiny tail. We let her run in a plastic ball all over the flat and she loves it! Once a day we give her some cheese and this is her special treat. While eating the cheese, she lies back, which is so cute, that I took a picture – that's her you can

see! She can also climb very well. I think that hamsters are just so sweet and cute!

The song is very catchy and so far every remix I’ve heard of it sounds as enchanting as the original. My favourite remix so far was done by BKAYE.




The song is about falling in love with someone based primarily on their appearance. The music video is also quite interesting.


