My future job.

I want to be a pilot. Despite the fact that his work is a very responsible one, I would like to be a plane pilot.

The pilot has a well-paid, interesting and important job. The captain of the plane commands the entire crew. The flight crew consists of: captain, co-pilot and flight attendants.

The flight begins with the external inspection of the aircraft. Then the captain leaves the plane and checks its technical condition. If he notices any malfunctions inside or outside the aircraft, he reports them to the mechanic who records this information on a special report.

Flight attendants check the equipment in trolleys on which they give away snacks, drinks, dishes and juices.

Later, before the crew lets passengers into the plane, pilots get a weather report. After getting the permit to let passengers in, when they are on the plane, pilots call the deicing station.

Then the mechanics spray the wings with a special deicing mixture. They do this because at high altitudes there is a low temperature, often below -20 degrees Celsius. If the wings are not covered with a special deicing mixture, then ice begins to form on the surface of the aircraft, which may lead to a stall and then a plane crash. After the deicing procedure, the pilots are waiting for another permit, this time for taxiing the aircraft to the position in front of the runway.

OUR FUTURE

There is a queue of planes to the runway. The flight controller allows the pilots to start at the right time. Before the plane starts, the pilots fill out a special list, thanks to which they do not forget about important procedures that were made before the start. Among other things, they extend the flaps to the right angle or check that the engine power is high enough to start. At the start there is a kind of culminating point, called "V1". It depends on the fact that if the plane is properly accelerated at the start, it cannot be stopped and you have to take off. When the plane is in the air, the flaps are extended because more lift is generated and the plane can rise. If the pilot forgets to eject them, the plane cannot rise due to lack of sufficient lift. There is usually a plane crash then.

After rising to the proper height, the captain retracts the flaps and does not reduce the power of the engines. Then the autopilot is usually turned on. Then, passengers can buy snacks from a cabin crew, go to the toilet, etc.

For landing, the captain opens the flaps again, turns off the autopilot, reduces the power of the engines and moves the landing gear out. After landing, the plane is going to a position where passengers are let out, and then - to the hangar.

As you can see, the pilot's work is very exciting and interesting.

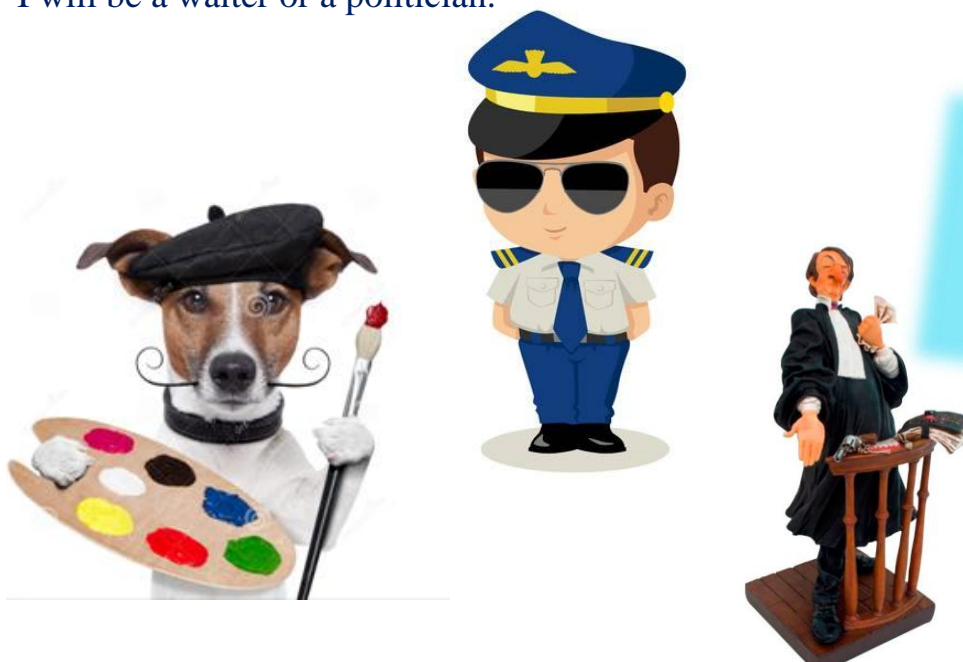

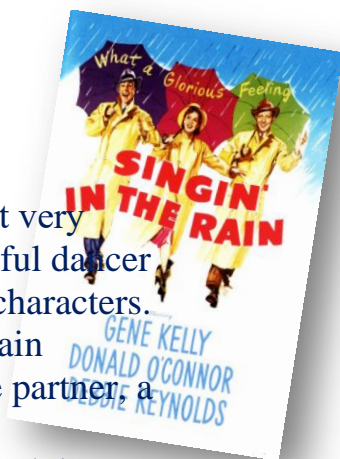


Movie Club Review

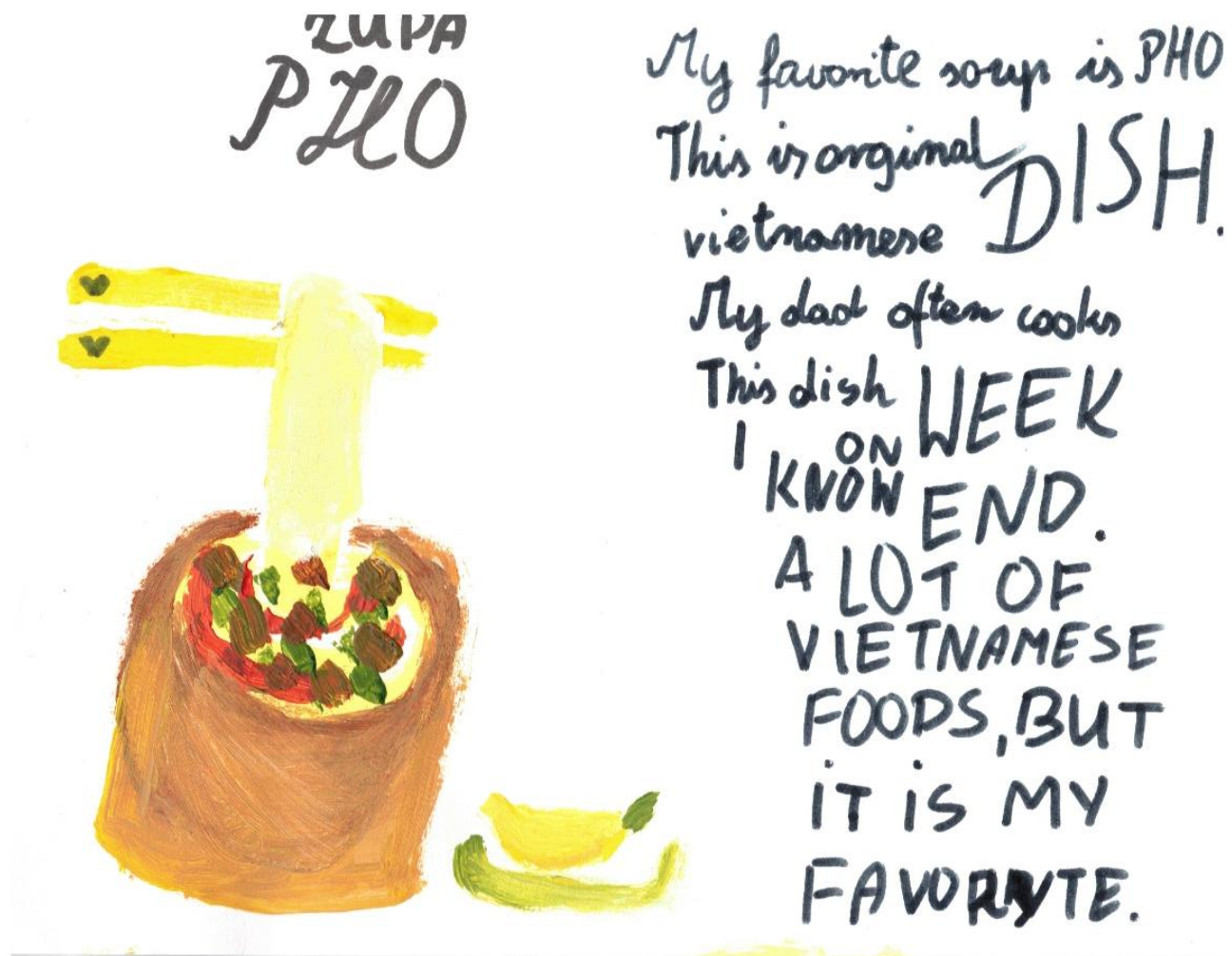
My favourite Vietnamese dish.

The beaver is a large, primarily nocturnal, semiaquatic rodent. Beavers are known for building dams, canals, and lodges (homes). They are the second-largest rodent in the world (after the capybara). Their colonies create one or more dams to provide still, deep water to protect against predators, and to float food and building material.

The beaver was given official status as an emblem of Canada on March 24, 1975.

In the late 1600s and early 1700s, the fashion of the day demanded fur hats, which needed beaver pelts. As these hats became more popular, the demand for the pelts grew.

There were an estimated six million beavers in Canada before the start of the fur trade. During its peak, 100,000 pelts were being shipped to Europe each year; the Canadian beaver was in danger of being wiped out. Luckily, about that time, Europeans took a liking to silk hats and the demand for beaver pelts all but disappeared. Today, thanks to conservation and silk hats, the beaver – the largest rodent in Canada – is alive and well all over the country.
