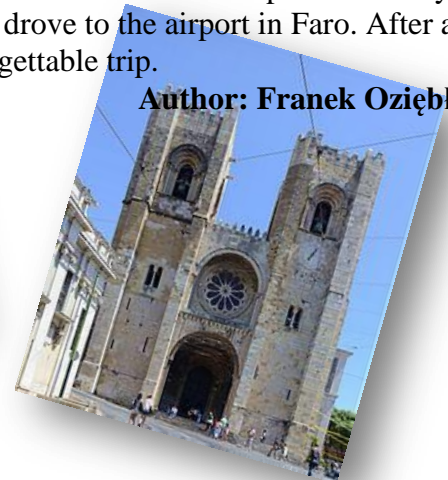

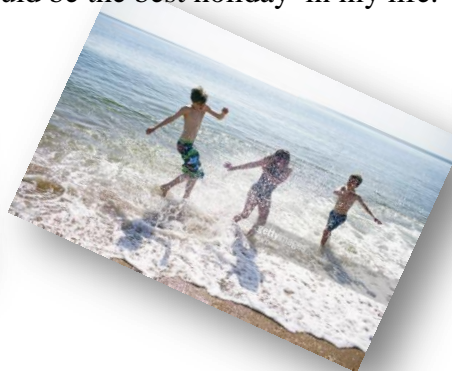

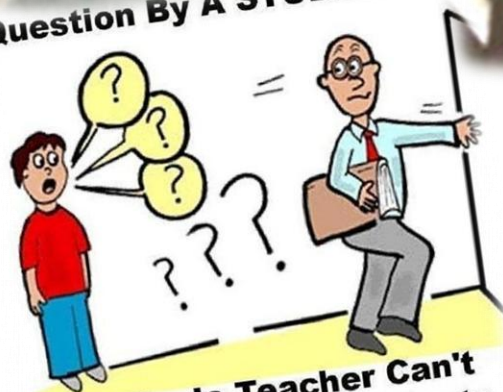

Zenon Martyniuk is one of the most popular vocalists of the disco polo genre and is considered to be the leading representative of the discopol-Gypsy trend. His most famous works include "Star", "The Queen of the Night", "Desire for Love", "Confidential Fate" or "Sonnet for Love", which he dedicated to his wife.

Zenek Martyniuk was born 23rd June 1969 in Gredele, Poland. He is 49 years old. In 1989 he founded the famous band „Akcent”. Two years later, member of his band, Mariusz Anikiel, left Poland, so the activity of the „Akcent” band has been suspended.

In 1993 the band was reactivated and it works without any interruptions to this day.

Along with Sławomir Świerzyński, Radosław Liszewski and Marcin Miller, he appeared at the 25th anniversary of Polsat television, performing the hit song "Through Your Eyes Green" in an orchestral arrangement.

He can sing in a Romani language.

Since February 4th, 1989, he is married to Danuta. They have got a son, Daniel. Zenon Martyniuk lives in Grabówka near Białystok

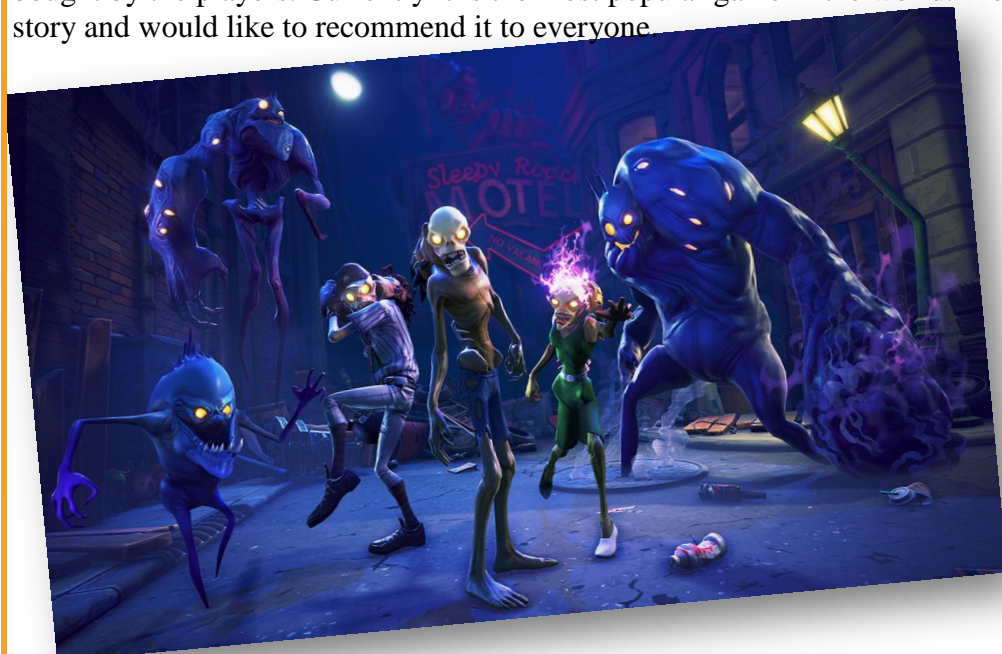

MY FAVOURITE COMPUTER GAME

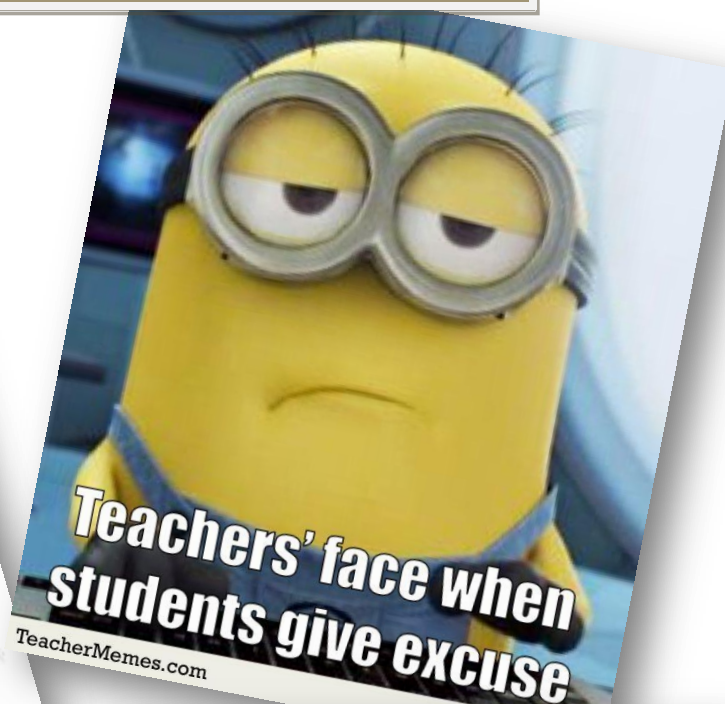
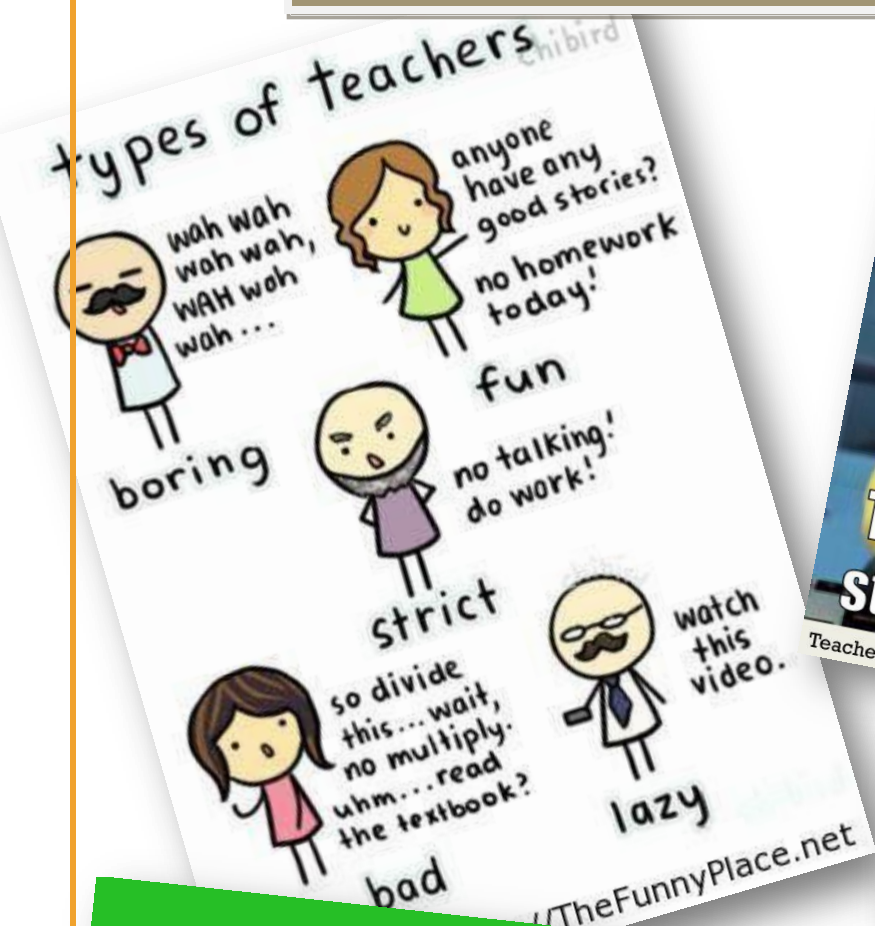
Fortnite

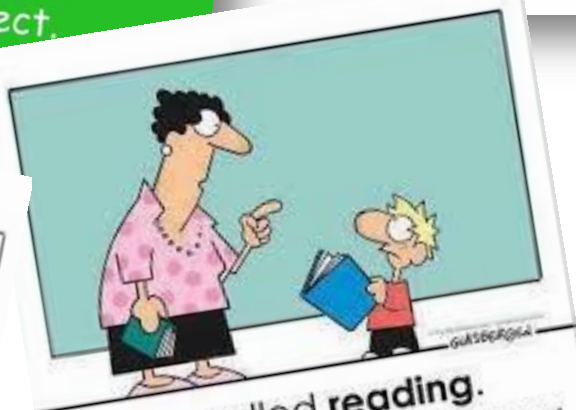
